Dear Parent/Carer

Every November schools throughout the United Kingdom take part in Anti-Bullying Week and we at Joyce Frankland Academy, Newport are doing so too. This is an opportunity to spotlight bullying and consider the steps we can take together to stop it. Anti-Bullying Week 2025 will take place from Monday 10th - Friday 14th November, with the theme: Power for Good. To support this theme, we are delivering an assembly to each year group, involving a local Police officer to deliver some key messaging and highlighting our 5 ways of reporting through the "Addressing Unkindness at JFAN Together" posters.

As a parent or carer, you are a vital piece of the puzzle in tackling bullying. You have a unique role to play in guiding and supporting your child through their school years and there are many positive steps you can take to help keep your child safe from bullying and harm. To help you in this role we have attached the Anti-Bullying Alliance Parent/Carer Support Pack, with guides and suggested activities to complete this week.

As a School, we at Joyce Frankland Academy, Newport take bullying seriously and building from our core values of Aspiration, Respect and Responsibility look to eradicate bullying completely. The underlying principle of our work in this area is to ensure that all students learn in a supportive, caring and safe environment without fear of being bullied, and feeling safe from any abusive, threatening or unpleasant behaviour.

With regards to embedding an anti-bullying culture our purpose is:

- to provide a safe and secure environment for all students.
- to encourage a culture of respect for each member of our community.
- to create a supportive climate and break down any code of secrecy.
- to counter and eliminate any idea that bullying is an inevitable part of school life.
- to work within an agreed set of procedures.
- to involve all adults, including parents/carers, and students in eradicating bullying.

If you or your child feel that they are being bullied, please encourage them to report it through our 5 methods of reporting outlined in the "Addressing Unkindness at JFAN Together Poster".
